Teachers use Google Classroom to send and receive assignments and communicate with students.

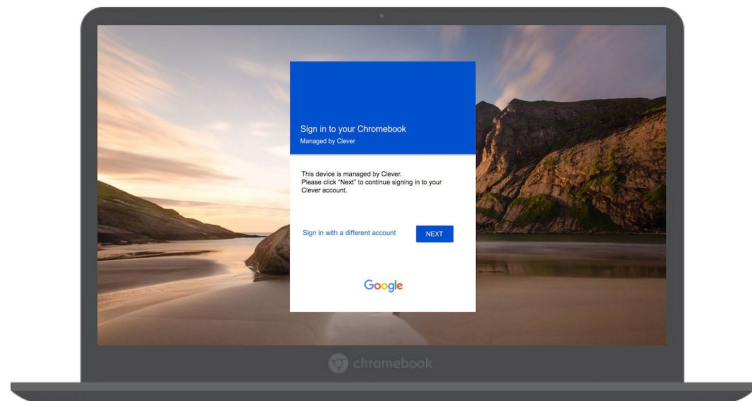




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Getting Started

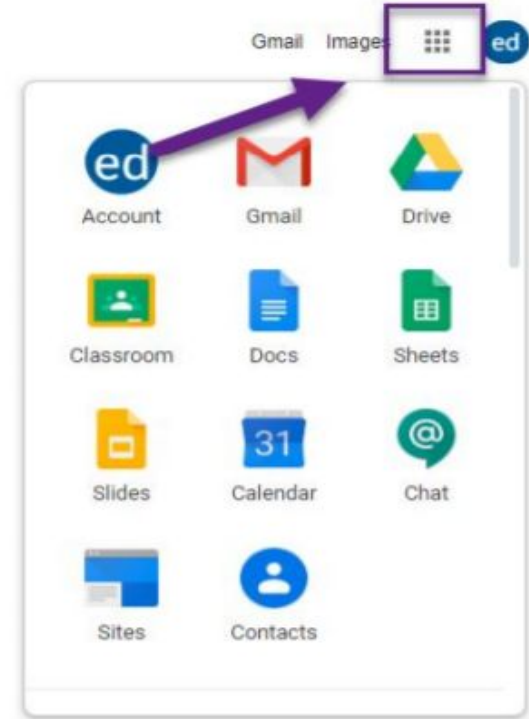

In the top right-hand corner of Google Chrome, click on the waffle





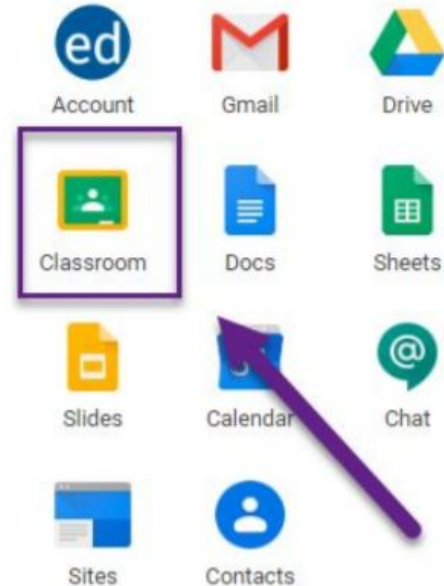
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Accessing Classroom

Click on the Google Classroom icon.

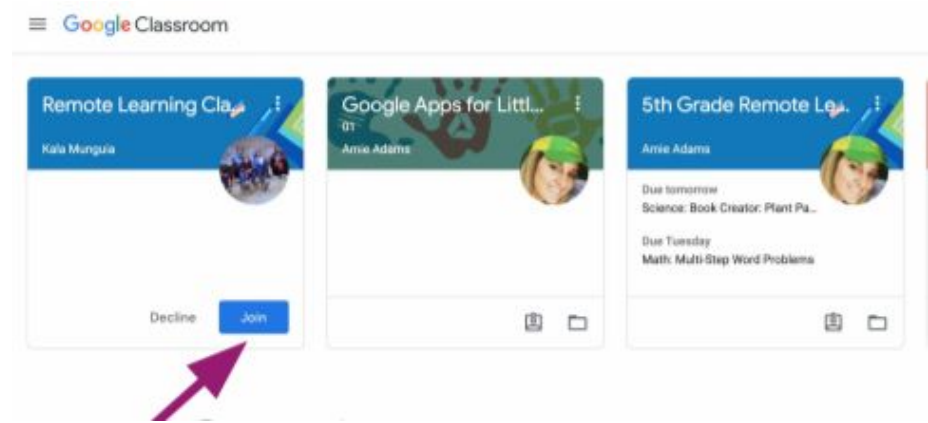
